Lab equipment includes tool, software, and hardware systems. Each student will have the opportunity to test their skills during a 160-hour supervised Information Technology Externship.

Our program will introduce students to the common tools and technologies IT professionals leverage to support computer users in today's businesses, though specific job responsibilities will vary depending on job title and type of company. Graduates of the Information Technology program receive a diploma.
