



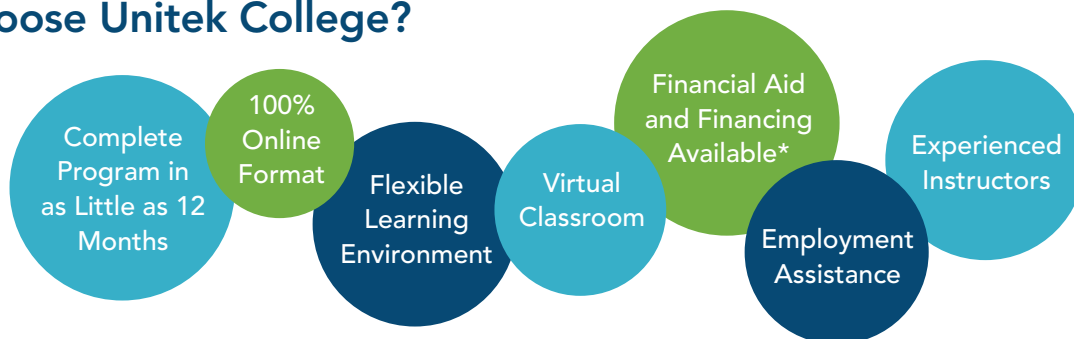
Prepare to Excel as a Licensed Vocational Nurse

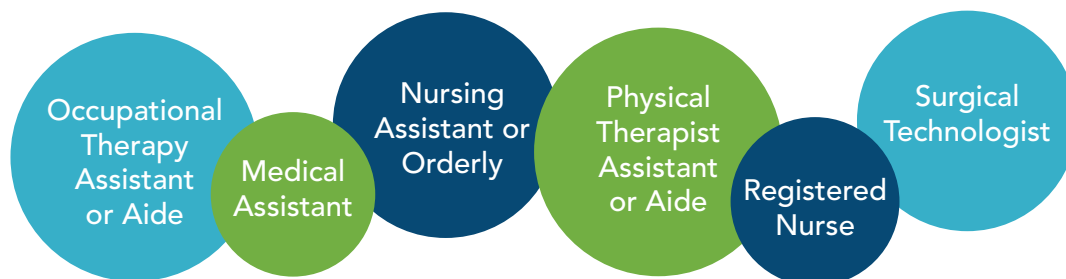

Growing Demand for Licensed Vocational Nurses

Increased patient numbers are driving demand for LVNs/LPNs. As a result, job opportunities are expected to grow much faster than other careers through 2028.¹ In May 2018, the median annual wage for Licensed Vocational Nurses was \$46,240, and the highest 10 percent earned more than \$62,160.¹
