Earning Potential for Vocational Nurses

Licensed Vocational Nurses earn a median annual wage of \$46,620, with the highest paid LVNs earning more than \$62,160.¹

Growing Demand for Vocational Nurses

Demand for Licensed Vocational Nurses is expected to grow 11 percent from 2018 to 2028, which is much faster than the average for all occupations. Currently, there are more than 728,900 Vocational Nursing jobs in the U.S., and an additional 78,100 jobs are expected to be added by 2028.¹
