A Licensed Vocational Nurse is a member of the healthcare team who works under the direction of physicians and registered nurses. The LVN provides direct client/patient care in a variety of settings such as, but not limited to: acute care hospital, convalescent, rehabilitation hospital, clinics, physician offices, home health, and hospice care.

Duties can range from simple to complex when providing basic care, assisting with activities of daily living, implementing procedures in assessment, obtaining vital signs, temperature, pulse, blood pressure, respiration, sterile dressing changes, administering medications, starting intravenous fluids, insertion of nasogastric tube, and providing tracheotomy care and suctioning.
